



CITY COUNCIL STAFF REPORT

MEETING DATE: September 23, 2024

ITEM TITLE: Appoint Parks, Recreation and Culture Commission (PR&C) Alternate Member Mark Stogner as a PR&C Voting Member to Fill a Term Ending June 30, 2025; and Appoint Alexandra Seeber from the PR&C Eligibility List to the Alternate Member Seat for a Term Expiring June 30, 2027.

RECOMMENDATION:

Staff provides no recommendation as commission appointments are made at the Council's discretion.

FISCAL IMPLICATIONS:

There are no fiscal implications associated with commission appointments.

BACKGROUND AND ANALYSIS:

In accordance with the Commissioner Handbook adopted by the Council, a Parks, Recreation and Culture Commissioner was removed from his seat on September 6, 2024 due to an accumulation of two unexcused absences within a fiscal year.

Notice of this unanticipated vacancy on the Commission was posted on September 6, 2024, pursuant to Government Code Section 54974.

The Council is being asked to consider appointing Alternate Member Mark Stogner as a PR&C Voting Member to fill the term ending June 30, 2025, and appointing Alexandra Seeber from the PR&C Eligibility List to the alternate member seat for a term expiring June 30, 2027.

ALTERNATIVES:

The alternatives available to the City Council include:

1. Appoint Parks, Recreation and Culture Commission (PR&C) Alternate Member Mark Stogner as a PR&C Voting Member to fill a term ending June 30, 2025; and appoint Alexandra Seeber from the PR&C Eligibility List to the alternate member seat for a term expiring June 30, 2027; or
2. Do not make appointments and direct staff to conduct a recruitment to fill the PR&C voting seat.
