NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT the San Carlos City Council will hold a Public Hearing at its Regular Meeting on **Tuesday, May 27, 2025 at 7:00 PM**, for the purpose of hearing and considering all comments of all persons interested in or concerned with the **Final Environmental Impact Report (EIR) and General Plan Amendments for the purpose of EIR certification and adoption of the 2045 General Plan Reset project.**

Project Description. On May 5, 2025, the San Carlos Planning and Transportation Commission adopted Resolution No. PTC2025-05 recommending that the City Council certify the EIR prepared for the 2045 General Plan Reset project, and adopted Resolution No. PTC2025-06 recommending that the City Council adopt the General Plan amendments as part of the 2045 General Plan Reset project.

CEQA. Pursuant to the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) Section 15060(d), the City of San Carlos has prepared an EIR to support the update of the 2030 General Plan that will reset development projections from 2030 to 2045 to accommodate continued interest in the development of new offices, restaurants, commercial uses and services, retail, industrial, and housing in the City.
