



CITY OF SAN CARLOS NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the San Carlos City Council will hold a Public Hearing in the Council Chambers, City Hall – 600 Elm Street, San Carlos, on **Monday, October 23, 2023 at 7:00 p.m.**, for the purpose of hearing and considering all comments of all persons interested in or concerned with the Planning and Transportation Commission's recommendation (PTC Resolution 2023-17) that the City Council hold a public hearing and consider introducing an ordinance to amend Title 18 (Zoning Ordinance) of the San Carlos Municipal Code to update the Accessory Dwelling Unit (ADU) and Junior Accessory Dwelling Unit (JADU) Ordinance.

The purpose of these amendments is to ensure that the Zoning Ordinance complies with recent state laws, to address the State's and City's housing goals, to facilitate construction of ADUs and JADUs, and to provide greater clarity of local regulations.

This update is consistent with the programs and policies of the San Carlos 2030 General Plan, including Goal HOU-3 of the recently adopted Housing Element. This update is within the scope of the activities and impacts identified in San Carlos 2030 General Plan Program Environmental Impact Report (EIR); no new environmental effects have been found, and no new mitigation is necessary. Therefore, no additional environmental review is required pursuant to Public Resources Code Section 21166 and California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) Guidelines Section 15162 and 15168.
